Do we still need abdominal surgery in the therapy of benign uterine disease?

Abstract: Uterine-saving surgical therapy, open or endoscopic, is a difficult measurement, routinely having reduced outcomes and only performed in few expert centers. The proposed ablative therapy proposes an organ saving concept, showing a definite statistically significant reduction of dysfunctional uterine bleeding and dysmenorrhea, avoiding hysterectomy and thereby leaving the possibility to become pregnant afterwards.
