**Abstract and paper submission:** Abstract should be submitted via e-mail as attached documents to: [president@serbianceramicsociety.rs](mailto:president@serbianceramicsociety.rs) **no later than June 1<sup>st</sup> 2017**, with the subject: **ACAVI-first name and surname** of the presenting author.

Abstracts should be prepared using the following instructions: paper size: A4; length: up to 200 words; language: English; font: Times New Roman; title: 14 pt, bold; authors' names: 12 pt, regular; affiliation and address: 12 pt, regular; body text: 12 pt; margins: top, bottom, inside, outside: 2 cm. Abstracts should contain the aim, methods and the conclusion of a research and should be without images and references.

**The authors should provide contact details** (e-mail and phone), their title (BSc, MSc, PhD), session for which the contribution is submitted, and type of presentation (oral /poster) **in the email body message**. The official language of the conference is **English**.

Conference abstracts will be published in the **Book of Abstracts**.
